Wood and Wire Bin — 36”

Instructions (Cont'd):

with hinges. If you want to paint or stain the wood do it now.

- Using pliers, attach wire ties to ends of circle together to maintain the circle.
- If desired, space and tie stakes within the circle to improve stability.

Adding materials:

- Add yard waste. If adding kitchen waste be sure to bury it deep in the middle so animals can't get to it.
- Occasionally lift the bin and place it next to the pile. Using a pitch fork or shovel, return the materials to the wood and wire bin.

Where to use:

- In a larger yard

Type of compost:

- Hot - if it is turned or mixed often enough to get hot
- Cold - if left for a year

Time/Cost:

- Total time to build - est. 2 1/2 hours
- Total est. cost - \$38.00
